A good example for a MPR is a living organism like the human body.

Although the body is a good example, the actual MPR and the process of creative union is not directly visible.

It is not possible to choose a certain part of the body and say, this is the MPR, or this is a certain level of the MPR.

MPRs are no visible shapes, they describe functions and relations within the body.

Only these functions and relations can be seen as the unifying process manifesting on various levels.

Out of this function, the different shapes of the parts and elements of the body can be explained.

Levels of the MPR

So the lowest level of the body's MPR will be the function of **biochemical reactions**. The corresponding shape will be the biochemical substances, including the DNA. The number and the type of biochemical elements will be determined by the reactions, they are used for.

Another basic level of the body's MPR will be the function of the **living cell**. Living cells in a way have their own individual existence. On the other hand, they are integrated in the function of the whole organism.

Out of this function, one can understand the distinct shape, that is visible in a microscope.

Another basic level of the body's MPR will be the functions of **the whole organism**, like digestion of food, breathing, blood circulation, temperature control, etc.

All these functions try to maintain a certain balance within the system. The functions are more or less interrelated, and try to create a harmonious unity.

The visible shape of these functions are the organs, like the heart, the lungs, the stomach etc..

Another basic level of the body's MPR are the **patterns of behaviour** of the whole organism. These patterns can be quite complicated, and they are usually centred around two topics: how to get food and how to find a sexual partner to have children.

Out of these patterns, one can understand the outer, physical shape of the body.


The highest level of the MPR is the level, where the MPR of the individual organism meets the MPR of the biological species. On this level the organism is integrated in the **life of the community**.

The visible shape of this level is the behaviour of the groups of organisms. In some cases this group behaviour can even create a kind of skeleton, like a beehive or a city of humans.

Creative Union

What is creative union ?

Creative union

Sexual union is a good example for the union of opposites.

However, although sexual union is a good example, the process of creative union is not directly visible.

One has to understand the functions and the flow of relation, to actually see creative union.

Creative union is manifesting on the top-level of the MPR. The top-level of the MPR is the transition from individual to collective behaviour.

If the MPR wants to grow, it will grow on the top-level. The top-level will appear and differentiate. This means, the MPR will manifest one side of the opposite.

Either the organism will play the role of a male, then the female aspect, the female function will disappear.

Or the organism will display the female function, then the male side will disappear.

When the two opposites meet, they can create a higher union. A new level of MPR is created, which has the shape of the two united bodies and their behaviour. The top-level of this MPR is the relation between the male and the female.

In this creative process a new organism can appear, who will carry on the growth process of both MPRs involved.

A new generation and a new type of behaviour is the visible shape of this creative union.
