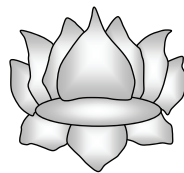

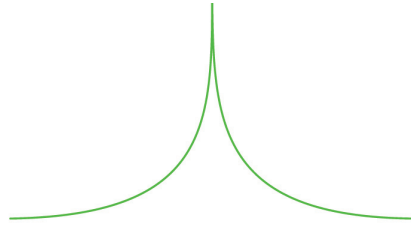

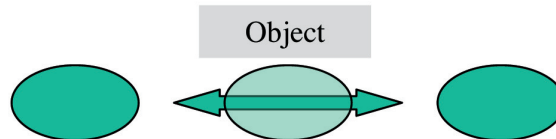
Relation



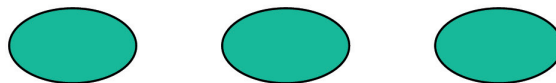
We are used to perceiving different objects.

A relation does not unify different objects,

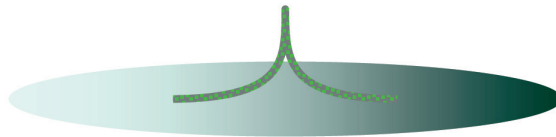




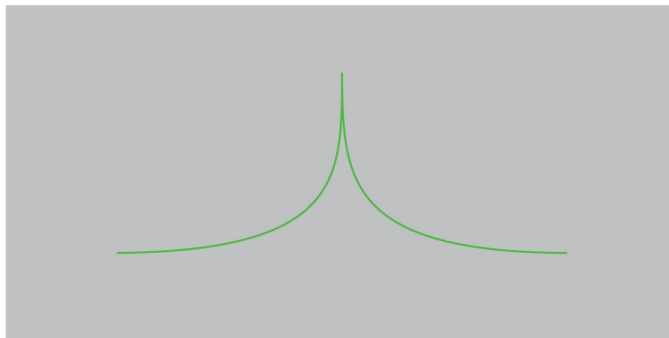
It combines differences and opposites



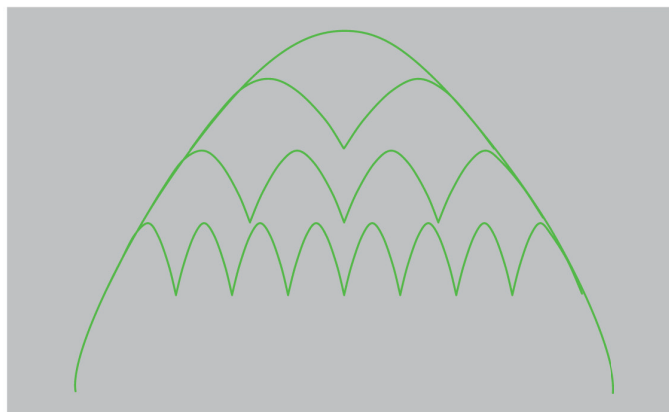
In a dynamic process.



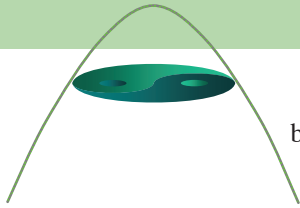
Relation is an independent reality, obeying its own rules.



WSP develops a model of these invisible relations.



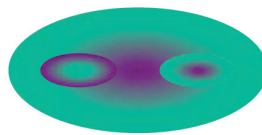
Union



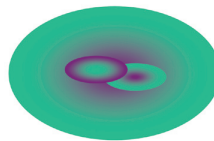
Every relation starts with a difference,
because without difference how could there be a relation?



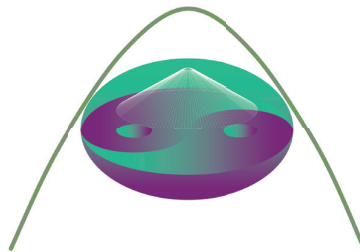
This difference intensifies into polarisation,
the greatest possible difference on a certain level.



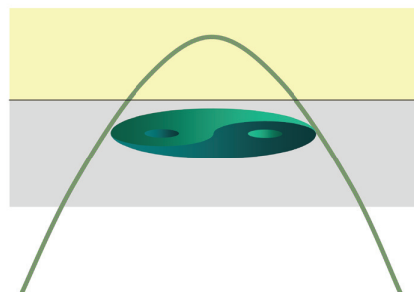
When the energy of the relation intensified further, it passes beyond
polarisation. This is a dangerous state, full of tension and conflict.



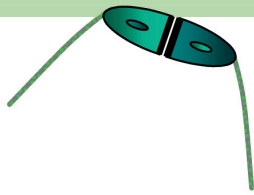
The union opens up a new dimension of the relation, absorbing the excessive energy. The initial
polarisation, the most intense relation on the lower level, is maintained and harmonised in this process.



The union opens up a new level of relation, thereby stabilising the old level.

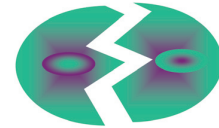
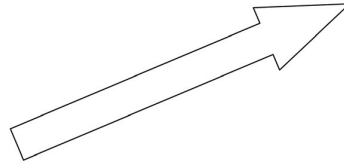
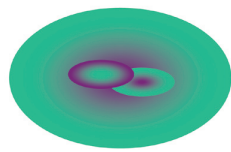


Distortion

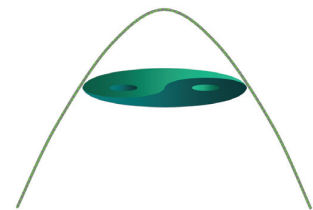
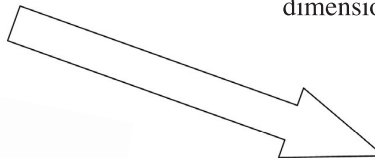


First, the relation may break apart, because the space of relation is too narrow

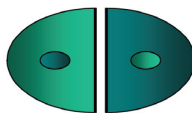
When the energy of the polarised relation is further intensified, three things can happen:



Second, the relation may grow into a new dimension, into a creative union.



Third, the relation may become stabilised on the lower level through a vicious circle.



This vicious circle binds the partners to each other without opening up a new dimension.
Instead of a higher union, there is a dominating shadow.
